Reduce your federal income tax liability by as much as \$9,600 per veteran hired. There is no limit on the number of individuals an employer can hire to qualify to claim the tax credit. Certain tax-exempt organizations can take advantage of WOTC by receiving a credit against the employer's share of Social Security taxes.
